Founded in 1970 and located on a 14-acre campus in North Miami Beach, Florida, Scheck Hillel Community School is one of the largest Jewish day schools in the world. The school serves more than 1,320 students from Early Childhood through Grade 12, achieving 100% college matriculation through a dual curriculum that combines rigorous college-preparatory general studies with a deep and joyful Modern Orthodox Judaic education.

Scheck Hillel families reflect the full breadth of the modern Jewish world, with roots across the United States, Latin America, Europe, and Israel, united by a shared commitment to academic excellence and lasting Jewish heritage. Alumni return as parents, educators, and community leaders. It is, in the fullest sense, a multigenerational institution.

A PK–12 Continuum of Excellence

Scheck Hillel's four divisions form a coherent, values-aligned PK–12 experience. A central opportunity for the next Head of School is elevating this continuum from individual divisions into a unified, school-wide system of excellence.

Early Childhood Education PKT (Pre Toddler) – PK4 (Pre Kindergarten)

A warm, multi-sensory, child-centered program blending play-based early childhood education and a love of learning from the very start.

Juda & Maria Diener Lower School Kindergarten – Grade 5

Foundational academics and Jewish identity formation, integrating Jewish values and Hebrew into daily life, nurturing curiosity and creativity with rigorous differentiated instruction.

Samuel & Henrietta Scheck Middle School Grades 6–8

Young adolescents are met where they are, intellectually, socially, and spiritually, with B'nei Mitzvah celebrations made more meaningful within the warmth of the Scheck Hillel community.

Ben Lipson Upper School Grades 9–12

An extensive range of AP and honors courses prepares students for top universities worldwide, complemented by Israel advocacy, senior capstone, and gap year programming.
